Hyperthermia as a medical treatment refers to heating the body or part of the body to higher than typical



Is it safe?

LRHT is generally safe and well tolerated when administered with an approved device by a qualified healthcare provider or technician. There are times when LRHT may not be safe, including patients with:

- Implanted medical devices
- Inability to feel or respond to pain
- Severe lung or heart disease
- Fever
- Organ transplant
- Recent surgery
- Poor circulation in the area
- Previous radiation to the area
